


Outside Cabin – a cabin with a picture window.

**Inside Cabin** – no window but with ample lighting, ventilation and air-conditioning.


**Twin Cabins, Staterooms, Mini-suites and Suites** - in these cabins there is the choice of a king-size bed or two lower beds. Additionally staterooms, mini-suites and suites have a sitting area.

NA, NB & NC Grades – please note that safety equipment blocks the view of all these cabins.

**Disabled Cabins** – all disabled cabins have twin beds, they do not have supplementary beds, with the exception of cabins D1 and D2 which do have supplementary berths. For the cabins with disabled facilities, the suites/minisuites have a bath and shower, other cabin types have a shower only. Disabled suites/minisuites have a standard bath. Additionally, the following cabins C194, C203, C1, C2, E95, E96, G11, G12, G74, G81 and G82 are suitable for disabled passengers. However, please be aware that opening the door from within the cabin, will require assistance from an able-bodied passenger.

**Shower only Cabins** – please note that some DB, DH, DI and KC grade cabins have a shower only. These include cabins C178, C180, C182, C185, C189, C191, D173 - D179, E1 - E8, E172, E176, E178, E179, E181, E183, G1 - G10.


**Balcony Cabins** – please note that cabins E1 - E42 have a metal balcony side and not the standard glass balcony side.




